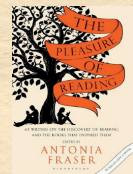

Give a Book is a UK-based charity that promotes books and the pleasure of reading in the hardest places. Our core belief is that to pass on a good read – to give a book – is a transaction of lasting worth. Our main work is in prisons, schools and with disadvantaged children.

Prison Reading Groups (PRG) began in 1999 and provides support and funding for reading groups in prisons across the UK. PRG is part of Give a Book.

Projects include:

- **Prison Reading Groups**
- **Raising Readers** – connecting parents inside with their children
- **Family Days in prison**
- **Whole School Reading Project**
- **Books for First Nighters** – books for people spending their first night in prison
- **Books in the Nick** – books for detainees in police custody suites
- **Book Clubs in Schools** – a peer-to-peer mentoring scheme in schools
