We are occasionally able to accept donations from the public and currently welcome enquiries if you have the following books in new or "as new" condition:

- Young Adult fiction and non-fiction
- Graphic novels and comic books
- Easy-read or dyslexia friendly books
- Fiction books in the following languages: Albanian, Polish, Romanian, Arabic, Vietnamese, Hungarian, Lithuanian, Portuguese, Latvian and Punjabi.
